### ***General Information***

#### **CONCERT ATTIRE and CHANGING INFORMATION for STUDENTS and PARENTS**

Do not bring luggage, garment bags, etc. into the auditorium. You may not change clothes at the auditorium. You must arrive in concert attire and leave in concert attire.

Middle school students should plan to come to the dress rehearsal wearing their concert attire. All high school students may change following their dress rehearsal at your hotel but may not bring luggage into Memorial Hall.

**Concert Attire** for men is a dark dress pant, a white shirt and a tie (coat optional but suggested) and for the women either a dark color dress or nice dark dress pants and a blouse. Many students may choose to wear formal concert attire “concert black” which would consist of a tuxedo for the gentlemen and either an all black dress or black dress and black blouse for the ladies. Formal concert black is not required but permissible.

#### **MEAL INFORMATION for STUDENTS**

For dinner on Friday and lunch on Saturday all students will have a meal ticket and be escorted by the Clinic Chair to the Lenoir Hall (Dining Hall). *This is paid for as a part of your clinic fee.* Students will walk to the Lenoir Hall (Dining Hall) at staggered times on Friday for dinner and again on Saturday for lunch. Each student will receive these meal tickets from the Clinic Chair for their band just prior to the meal.

Breakfast on Saturday morning and Dinner on Saturday night is the responsibility of the student and director.

#### **HOUSING INFORMATION for STUDENTS, PARENTS, and DIRECTORS**

All students are to be housed in area hotels (a list is provided on the NCBA website). Directors will make hotel reservations and make arrangements for transportation to and from the campus. Directors are responsible for registering students at the Honors Band Clinic and bringing all necessary payments and requested documents. Directors are also responsible for chaperoning and supervising their students, in person, for the entire weekend.

**Parents may not register students for the North Carolina Honors Band Clinic or supervise students in place of their band director throughout the weekend.**

## ***Driving Information***

### **From Raleigh...**

*To Town Pay Parking Lots*

- » Take I-40W toward Chapel Hill, take exit 273A to Chapel Hill.
- » When you reach campus, stay straight. The road becomes South Road.
- » Turn right onto Columbia Street.
- » Turn right onto Rosemary Street. There are pay lots on the left and right side of the street.

*To Memorial Hall*

- » Take I-40W toward Chapel Hill, take exit 273A to Chapel Hill.
- » When you reach campus, turn right onto Country Club Drive.
- » When the road turns into Cameron Avenue, Memorial Hall will be on your left after 0.2 miles.

### **From Durham...**

*To Town Pay Parking Lots*

- » Take 15-501S toward Chapel Hill.
- » Once in Chapel Hill, when the road forks, exit right onto Franklin Street.
- » Turn right onto Henderson Street.
- » Turn at the next left onto Rosemary Street. There are pay lots on the left and right side of the street.

*To Memorial Hall*

- » Take 15-501S toward Chapel Hill.
- » Once in Chapel Hill, when the road forks, exit right onto Franklin Street.
- » Turn left onto Raleigh Street.
- » Turn at the next right onto Cameron Avenue, Memorial Hall will be on your left after 0.2 miles.

### **From Greensboro/Winston-Salem...**

*To Town Pay Parking Lots*

- » Take I-40E toward Chapel Hill, take exit 266 toward Chapel Hill. You will now be on Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.
- » Follow this road approximately 3.4 miles into downtown Chapel Hill.
- » Turn left onto Rosemary Street. There are pay lots on the left and right side of the street.

*To Memorial Hall*

- » Take I-40E toward Chapel Hill, take exit 266 toward Chapel Hill. You will now be on Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.
- » Follow this road approximately 3.5 miles into downtown Chapel Hill.
- » Turn left onto Cameron Avenue, Memorial Hall will be on right after less than 0.1 miles.

There is no charge to park there, but spots are available on a first-come, first-served basis.</p> <p>2) <b><i>The UNC Global FedEx Visitors' Lot</i></b>   15-min walk to Memorial Hall Located at the corner of Columbia and McCauley, behind The Carolina Inn.
