Junior High Planning Committee

The junior high planning committee met on January 28th, 1978, to discuss the possibilities of devising a strong junior high session at the 1978 N.C. Music Educators National Convention. Ann Wilson, president of the junior high section presided. The meeting was held in Raleigh at the Educational Building. Here are the results of the meeting.

Excellent

The committee decided that the Convention would consist of four junior high sessions. These important sessions would take place on Sunday afternoon, Monday morning and afternoon, and Tuesday morning. The committee talked about the possibility of inviting Michael Bennet of Pops Hits Publishing Company to do a workshop on Sunday afternoon. Mr. Bennet is the author of the book "Surviving in General Music", an excellent guide for the 7th grade exploratory teacher. His workshop would be a definite asset for the Convention. On Monday morning, the committee thought that a junior high choral reading session with Don Hinshaw would be valuable. All teachers need to be aware of repetory and this session would allow teachers to bring choral music that has worked for them and share it with others. The committee wants all teachers to be notified in advance of this session so that a sufficient amount of music will be available. A small business meeting would be held on Monday morning also. On Monday afternoon, the committee would like to have a "Sharing of Ideas" workshop where several activities would be going on. The Swing choir and Songsters from Fort Bragg would perform as well as an improvisational encounter with Ann Jones. Also, a display of ideas and materials for learning centers would be set up for those teachers who need to expand their individualized instruction program. The most exciting event the committee decided on was the Tuesday morning session which would be based on choreography and music. The committee would like to see dance put to music both "on and off the Risers". We would like to bring students from various schools to participate in an on the spot improvisational dance and music encounter. We would also like to have a
